




- All 6 sites have been installed with Geo Therm technologies, with the final one being completed in July 2025
- Since Jan 2023 energy consumption has reduced by a total of 2,093,756 kWh's (to July 2025)
- 2023 saw an initial energy cost reduction of £75k. Additional savings (2) of £2.023M have been achieved through energy cost negotiation and continued reduced in kWh consumption.

Energy Reduction


